- 1. Write a note on convergence of corporate interests in the context of convergence media.
- 2. Media ownership patterns in India have undergone a massive change in last few years. Discuss.
- 3. Write a brief note on the possible future of media in the context of internet.
- 4. Discuss the relationship between media and social change with examples.
- The concept of media imperialism is developed within a broader analysis of cultural imperialism. Comment.

SECTION: B

(Attempt any two questions. Each question carries 10 marks. (400-500 words each)

(Marks: 10X2=20)

- There is an ongoing process of emergence of de facto global governance without a global government. Discuss this in the context of the concept of 'network society.
- 2. Media and cultural forms which originated in America have come to symbolise social and cultural modernisation. Comment.
- 3. Mass media can be an instrument for political propaganda and shape the worldview of citizens. Discuss.

SECTION: C

Attempt only one question. The question carries 15 marks. (600 words minimum)

- 1. Global circulation of media products shows disparities in the volume and economic values of such products. Examine this in the context of various historical, geo-political, economic and cultural factors that determine the international information flow.
- 2. Discuss the role of media in international politics. Also refer to Noam Chomsky's thesis of manufacturing consent in this context.
