

About Doon University

Established by the Government of Uttarakhand by an Act of State Legislature in 2005, the Doon University commenced its first academic session in 2009 with an intake of 77 students in two Schools -- School of Environment and Natural Resources and School of Communication. Though still young and evolving, the University has reasonably established itself well in a relatively short span of its academic journey. With over 2800 students enrolled in 9 Schools in the current academic session, the University is catering to a number of students in Uttarakhand as well as other states through a wide range of academic courses with a mandate of providing socially and economically relevant quality education. Over the years, this institution has attained several milestones emerging as a Center of excellence in diverse fields of education.

Recent Highlights

Implementation of National Education Policy 2020

The University has implemented National Educational Policy 2020 in all the undergraduate programs. Apart from implementing the comprehensive framework of NEP 2020, there will be a provision of multiple entry and exit for the students who have been admitted in different programs in July/August 2022.

Addition of New Faculty Members in the University Family

Process of recruitment is going on for last one and a half year. So far, twenty-one members have been added in the University family during 2021-2022.

Infrastructure Development

Infrastructure development is taking place rapidly. Building of Dr. Nityanand Himalayan Research and Study Centre has come into existence in 2022. Department of Geology, Department of Geography, Dr. Nityanand Auditorium, Dr. Ambedkar Chair Centre, and Department of Folk Theatre and Performing Arts are existent in this newly established building. Separate block/building for the School of Management is under construction. It is likely to be ready within six months.

National Seminar on "Development Experiences of Uttarakhand"

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Department of Economics organized two-days National Seminar and Researchers' Conclave on "Development Experiences of Uttarakhand" during September 23-24, 2022. Over 100 academicians, policy experts and researchers participated to discuss two decades of development experiences of the state. Prof. Ramesh Chand Member (Member, NITI Aayog), Prof. S.P. Singh (Former Vice Chancellor, HNB Garhwal University), Shri Sanjeev Chopra (Former Director-General, LBS Academy of Administration), Dr. N. 

This centre will be the new hub for innovation with the aim to empower students with innovation, and creativity inputs for creating future student entrepreneurship opportunities along with focusing on digital humanity. The centre is coordinated by Prof. R.P. Mamagain and Dr. Sudhanshu Joshi is the Member Secretary. The centre initially has a team of twelve members with two distinguished industrial representatives.

Establishment of Doon University-Banakar Centre of IPR

Doon University has approved establishment of Doon University-Banakar Centre of IPR in March 2022 by signing MoU with Banakar Consulting Services, USA. This centre has the objectives to serve and promote awareness of IPR within the academic as well as technical/ scientific centers/organizations of the state of Uttarakhand. In near future, this centre will evolve as the academic center for IPR. With the help of this centre, the University is organizing professional advancement programs. This centre will also work to integrate IP in the academic curricula of DU, provide IP services (advisory, clinic, etc.) to institutions, professional associations, research centers, professional technical programs (engineering, health sciences, pharmaceutical sciences, agricultural sciences, etc.)

Implementation of New Policies

Doon University Incentivization Policy entitled "Encomium":

Doon University supports and promotes the research activities of the faculty members who continuously strive to elevate the research credentials and achievements of the University. There may be some or many faculty members whose academic credentials and achievements are recognized (in the form of awards/rewards/medals/certificates) at the state, national and international forums. For the official appreciation of such faculty members, the University, in addition to its other research promotion scheme(s), has the policy entitled "Encomium". Encomium has the provision to honor such awardees at some of the official university-level functions/programmes.

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• University Research Policy (DU-RP) 2021:

In order to enhance the quality in higher education, the University considers the research and innovation to be very important aspects. In view of this consideration, there is a Doon University Research Policy (DU-RP) 2021. This policy envisages the promotion of quality research within the University. The implementation of the research policy is catalysing the multidisciplinary/ transdisciplinary and translational research culture in the University.

• Doon University Consultation Policy (DU-CP):

The university, encourages its faculty and staff to engage in consultancy wherever appropriate, and in a manner that is in conformity with their service agreement with the university. For such academicians and/or researchers who share their knowledge and expertise with corporate and other external agencies through the channel of consultancy, the University has this policy. Consultancy activities in the University may be associated with contractual relationships, including research, service contracts etc. with government non-government organizations in lieu of a fee.

• Doon University Incentivization Policy entitled "STIMULUS":

Research and Development (R&D) is an integral and important part of Doon University. For promoting quality research and encouraging potential researchers, the University has the scheme entitled 'STIMULUS'. Under this scheme, there are the provisions for providing the faculty members with the seed money.

Establishment of Centre for Wellness (viz. Counselling Cell)

The University has approved to create and establish this centre under the aegis of Department of psychology to provide psychological support to students/staffs/ faculties of Doon University and others. Another objective of this centre is to help the individuals to identify full potential and develop psychological resilience and skills to deal with various challenges of life.

Establishment of Happiness Laboratory

The University has approved to create and establish this laboratory under the aegis of Department of psychology to enhance happiness among students/ staffs/ faculties of the University. This laboratory helps to focus on various functional aspects of life by using the principle of positive psychology. It provides aids to the individuals in building psychological resilience and immunity.

Establishment of Yoga Health Care Centre

The University has approved to create and establish this centre under the aegis of Department of Psychology to provide physical and psychological support to students/staff/ faculties of Doon University and others. Other functions of this centre are to provide holistic health care by providing both mental and physical well-being techniques, to enhance social and spiritual well-being, and to encourage people to live a healthy life and eliminate suffering through proper diet and practices.

Sports Activities

Interschool tournaments were organized for Badminton, Volleyball, Basketball, Football, Table tennis, and Chess. In badminton, thirty-two students participated from six schools in five category singles and doubles (men's and women's), and mix doubles. In Volleyball, twelve teams participated from five schools. In basketball, eight teams participated from four schools.



In football, seven teams participated from four schools. In table tennis, thirty-two students participated. A large number of students (i.e., 52) participated in Chess. As far as all India university representation is concerned, ten students participated in round of 128 matches for both men's and women's in badminton.



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School of Biological Sciences

Aims and Objectives

The School of Biological Sciences (SoBS) has been established recently in the year 2021. It is a multidisciplinary School with teaching and research focused on understanding and conserving the life on earth. The School is mandated to become a Center of excellence in the field of biological sciences in the country and the world. The School is committed to excellence in cutting edge scientific research and building capacities of trained professionals who can meet the emerging challenges in conserving life on Earth.

The mission of the School is:

- To build capacities in the field of biological science through degree, and research programmes
- To undertake cutting edge scientific research in the emerging areas of biological sciences (microbiology, biotechnology, virology, bioprocess technology, biochemistry, diagnostics and health sciences)
- To undertake research on health and environmental issues with policy implications for the state and the country
- To forge academic and research collaborations with well recognized institutions of national and international prominence

Current Status and Future Perspectives of the School

Uttarakhand is an environmentaly sensitive state and known for its biodiversity. The knowledge and understanding of biological sciences are necessary to understand the complex nature of our land, solve the existing issues, and protect the ecology of the Himalayan State. The School integrates with other Schools such as School of Environment and Natural Resources and School of Physical Sciences (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Computer Science). The SoBS is a unique School in the state of Uttarakhand which offers degree programme in Biological Science. The School will further expand in coming years to offer PhD programme and other Master courses.

Academic Programmes at the School

- The School offers an integrated MSc Biological Sciences programme. The first batch of the students has been admitted recently for the academic session 2021-2022. However, there is an option for the students to exit after completion of three years with a degree of BSc (Hons.). International students can also take admission to this course as per the admission norms for the foreign nationals. Fifteen percent seats above and over the sanctioned seats are reserved for foreign nationals.
- The curriculum of the programme is based upon UGC's choice-based credit system (CBCS) and provides an in-depth study of the subject and the related areas. The foundation of the subject is built through Core courses coupled with a choice-based specialisation of different streams of modern biology with an interdisciplinary perspective through Elective courses. Core courses are rigorous in-depth courses that build on the foundation and develop critical thinking and problem-solving skills.
- Since the subjects involve a lot of experimental work, substantial laboratory work is an
 integral part of almost all types of courses. All students have to undertake a research
 project under the guidance of highly qualified faculties and the outcome of the research
 will be reported in the form of a dissertation.
- Students will be encouraged to take up summer projects and visit institutes and universities of national repute such as IITs, NITs, IISER, CSIR Labs during the 5-year course.

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- The School also has plan to start a PhD degree programme in the thrust areas of microbial technology, genetic engineering, industrial microbiology, diagnostics and health sciences, environmental microbiology and biotechnology.
- The establishment of a Center of Biotechnology is also proposed in the School. This Center will train the graduate students of bioengineering. The Center has plan to offer 2-year M. Tech. in biotechnology course.

Facilities

- Some of the high-end analytical instruments which are available in the University include PCR, RT-PCR, Gel-Doc system, FPLC, HPLC, GC-MS, GC-FID, Plant Growth Chamber, LICOR and Bioreactor.
- The School will develop a world class infrastructure with state-of-the-art laboratory facilities in the future and the School will further expand the facilities to strengthen the teaching and research activities.

Dr. Achlesh Daverey, Coordinator of the School, is listed in top 2% Scientists in the world ranking of 2021 released by Stanford University and Elsevier. His rank in the field of Biotechnology is 1028.

School of Design

The School of Design offers a four-year Bachelor of Design programme. The teaching pedagogy lays emphasis on creative thinking and critical analysis. Hands-on approach is adopted as much as possible to enhance the learning experience of the students. The programme focuses on nurturing the creative aptitude in each student and develops their ability to evolve in the process of problem solving. Emphasis is given to design education in relation to our ecosystem and Society that we live in as well as the environment, which we need to preserve. Two specialisations are offered to students: (i) Graphic Design and (ii) Product Design: 04 Year Course (01 year common + 03 years discipline specific).



- The School of Design stresses upon vocational, practice-oriented design education and offers studio infrastructure at par with other national institutes.
- The School has created strong relations with the design fraternity and the industry in Uttarakhand and elsewhere. The curriculum is oriented to educate and impart skills to students geared to meet the requirements of the burgeoning design ecosystem in India.
- Our vision is to be one of the leading design schools in India with a strong presence in research and design services. We aim to educate responsible designers who are creative thinkers and have skills to conceptualize and develop their designs in a professional capacity. As part of the prestigious Doon University, we will strive to have a multidisciplinary approach and explore inter-linkages of design with the social and natural sciences.
- The School of Design also endeavours to foster design education in the state of Uttarakhand and raise design awareness at all levels of education.
- The School of Design aims to encourage indigenous design solutions, building upon traditional knowledge systems. It encourages universal and accessible design solutions for the masses.



The Indian Himalayan Region is rich in its diverse ecosystems entailing a rich biodiversity of species and genetic levels, supplemented by ethnic and cultural diversity. - The Bachelors and Masters students are encouraged to pursue research work in current demanding areas. The Masters students are working on different research projects in collaboration with national and international organisations.
- The Department is about to organise various technology/skill enhancement programmes in collaboration with various companies to improve the job employability of students

- Women's programme on "Data Analytics" is scheduled in the mid of Feb 2022 for final year female students.

Department of Chemistry

The Department came into existence in July 2015 under the aegis of the School of Physical Sciences (SoPS). Integrated MSc Chemistry (5 years) and PhD Chemistry (3-6 years) courses are offered at the Department.

Students are involved in carrying out research in various research fields (including Energy harvesting Materials, Photocatalysis on Semiconducting Nanostructures, Material Science, Organic Syntheses, Catalysis and Coordination Chemistry).

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
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
