STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

An Act further to amend the Constitution of India

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Thirteenth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. Short title.-This Act may be called the Constitution (Fourteenth Amendment) Act, 1962.

- 2. Amendment of article 81.-In article 81 of the Constitution. in members", sub-clause (b) of clause (1),for the words "twenty the words "twenty-five members" shall be substituted.
- of the First 3. Amendment Schedule.-In the First Schedule the Constitution. under the heading "II. THE **UNION** TERRITORIES", after entry 8, the following entry shall be inserted, namely:-
- "9. Pondicherry The territories which immediately before the sixteenth of 1962. day August, were comprised the French Establishments in in India known Pondicherry, Karikal. Mahe as and Yanam.".
- 4. Insertion of new article 239A.-After article 239 of the Constitution, the following article shall be inserted, namely:-
- "239A. Creation of local Legislatures or Council of Ministers or both for certain Union territories.-(1) Parliament may by law create for of the Union territories of Himachal Pradesh, Manipur, Tripura, any Goa, Daman and Diu, and Pondicherry-
- (a) a body, whether elected or partly nominated and partly elected, to function as a Legislature for the Union territory, or
- (b) a Council of Ministers,
- or both with such constitution, powers and functions, in each case, as may be specified in the law.

- 5. Amendment of article 240.-In article 240 of the Constitution, in clause (1),-
- (a) after entry (d), the following entry shall be inserted, namely:-
- "(e) Pondicherry:";
- (b) the following proviso shall be inserted at the end, namely:-
- "Provided that when any body is created under article 239A to function Legislature for the Union territory of Goa. Daman and Diu as or Pondicherry, President the shall not make any regulation for the of that Union with peace, progress and good government effect from the date appointed for the first meeting the Legislature.".
- 6. Amendment of the Fourth Schedule.-In the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution, in the Table,-

- (a) after entry 20, the entry
- "21. Pondicherry1" shall be inserted;
- (b) for the figures "225", the figures "226" shall be substituted.
- 7. Retrospective operation of certain provisions.-Section 3 and clause (a) of section 5 shall be deemed to have come into force on the 16th day of August, 1962.
