STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

Constitution (Fifty-first Amendment) Act, 1984 was enacted to of the provide for reservation of seats in the House People for the Scheduled Tribes in Nagaland, Meghalaya, Mizoram and Arunachal Pradesh and also for reservation of seats for Scheduled Tribes the Legislative Assemblies of Nagaland and Meghalaya by suitably amending articles 330 332. Even though these States and are predominantly tribal areas, the underlying objective of the aforesaid Act was to that the members of the Scheduled Tribes ensure in these areas do not secure a minimal representation because of their inability to complete with the advanced sections of the people.

THE CONSTITUTION (FIFTY-SEVENTH AMENDMENT)
ACT. 1987

[15th September, 1987.]

An Act further to amend the Constitution of India.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Thirty-eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- 1. Short title and commencement.-(1) This Act may be called the Constitution (Fifty-seventh Amendment) Act, 1987.
- (2) It shall come into force on such date_675 as the Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.
- 2. 332.-(1) Amendment of article In article 332 of the Constitution. after clause (3),the following clause shall be inserted, namely:-
- ''(3A)Notwithstanding anything contained in clause (3),until the taking effect, under article 170. of the re-adjustment, on the basis of the first census after the year 2000, of the number of seats in the of the Legislative Assemblies States of Arunachal Pradesh, Meghalaya, Mizoram and Nagaland, the seats which shall be reserved for Scheduled Tribes in the Legislative Assembly of any such State shall be,-
- Assembly (a) if all the seats in the Legislative of such State of of existence on the date coming into force the Constitution 1987 this (Fifty-seventh Amendment) Act, (hereafter in clause referred as the existing assembly) are held by members of the Scheduled Tribes, all the seats except one;
- (b) in any other case, such number of seats as bears to the total number of seats, a proportion not less than the number (as on the said

- date) of members belonging the Scheduled Tribes in the existing to in Assembly bears to the total number of seats the existing Assembly.".
- (2) The amendment made to article 332 of the Constitution by subsection shall not affect any representation in the Legislative (1) the State of Arunachal Pradesh or the Legislative Assembly of Assembly of the State of Meghalaya or the Legislative Assembly of the State of Mizoram or the Legislative Assembly of the State of Nagaland until the dissolution of the Legislative Assembly of the State of Arunachal Pradesh or the Legislative Assembly of the State of Meghalaya or Legislative Assembly of the State of Mizoram or the Legislative Assembly of the State of Nagaland existing at the commencement of this Act.
