THE CONSTITUTION (SIXTY-FIFTH AMENDMENT) ACT 1990

[7th June, 1990.]

An Act further to amend the Constitution of India.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Forty-first Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

- 1. Short title and commencement.-(1) This Act may be called the Constitution (Sixty-fifth Amendment) Act, 1990.
- (2) It shall come into force on such date_677 as the Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

- 2. Amendment of article 338.-In article 338 of the Constitution,-
- (a) for the marginal heading, the following marginal heading shall be substituted, namely:-
- "National Commission for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.";
- (b) for clauses (1) and (2), the following clauses shall be substituted, namely:-
- "(1)There shall be a Commission for the Scheduled Castes and **Tribes** Scheduled to be known as the **National** Commission for the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
- Subject to the provisions of any in law made this behalf Parliament, shall ofthe Commission consist a Chairperson, and five the conditions of service Vice-Chairperson other Members and office and tenure of the Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson and other Members appointed shall be such as the President SO may by rule determine.
- (3) The Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson and other Members of the Commission shall be appointed President by the by under his warrant hand and seal.
- (4) The Commission shall have the power to regulate its own procedure.
- (5) It shall be the duty of the Commission-
- (a) investigate and relating safeguards to all matters the Scheduled Scheduled **Tribes** under provided for the Castes and this Constitution or under any other law for the time being in force or order of the Government and to evaluate the working of such under any safeguards;
- (b) to inquire into specific complaints with respect the to deprivation of rights and safeguards of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes:
- (c) to participate and advise on the planning process of socio-economic development of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes and to evaluate the progress of their development under the Union and any State;
- annually other (d) present to the President, and at such times as the Commission may deem fit, reports upon the working of those safeguards;
- (e) to make in such reports recommendations as to the measures that should be taken by the Union or any State for the effective implementation those safeguards and other for the of measures

protection, welfare and socio-economic development of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes; and

- discharge such other functions in relation to protection, (f) to the development welfare and and advancement of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled **Tribes** as the President may, subject to the provisions of any law made by Parliament, by rule specify.
- President shall cause all such reports to be laid before each House ofParliament along with a memorandum explaining the action taken or proposed be taken on the recommendations relating to the Union and the the non-acceptance, if any, of any of reasons for such recommendations.

- (a) summoning and enforcing the attendance of any person from any part of India and examining him on oath;
- (b) requiring the discovery and production of any document;
- (c) receiving evidence on affidavits;
- (d) requisitioning any public record or copy thereof from any court or office:
- (e) issuing commissions for the examination of witnesses and documents;
- (f) any other matter which the President may, by rule, determine.
