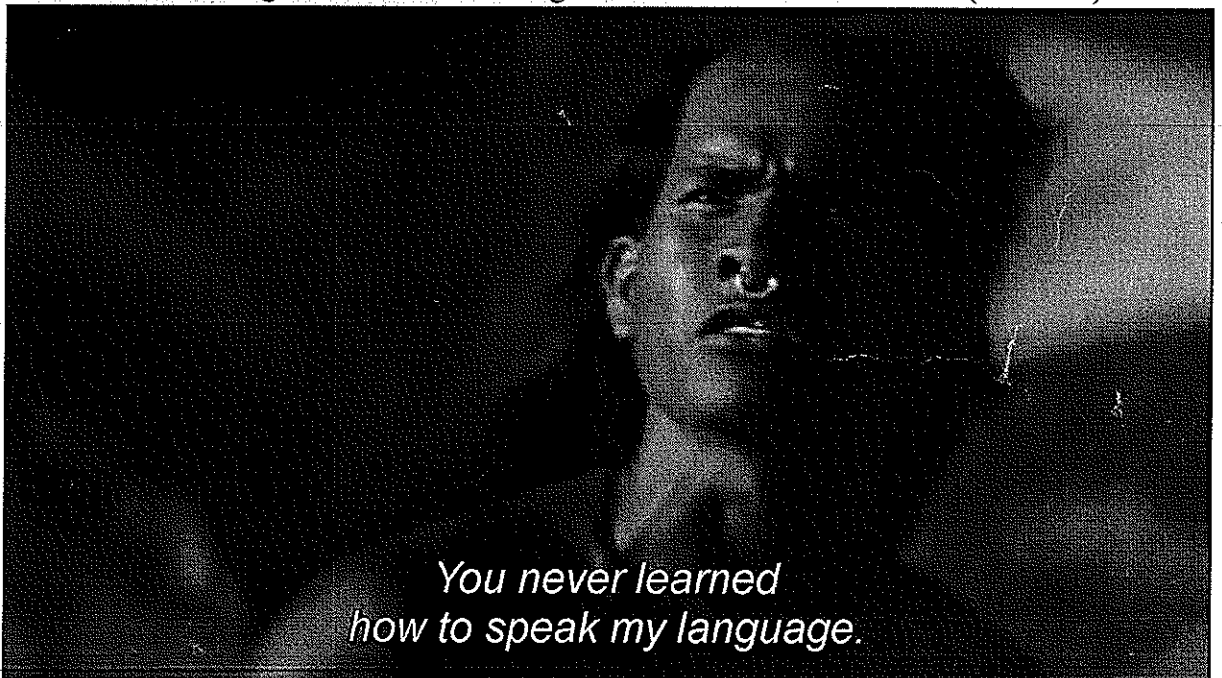

2. Following is a screenshot from a film that was shown in the class. Recognize the film and talk about the significance of the dialogue. (Marks: 5)

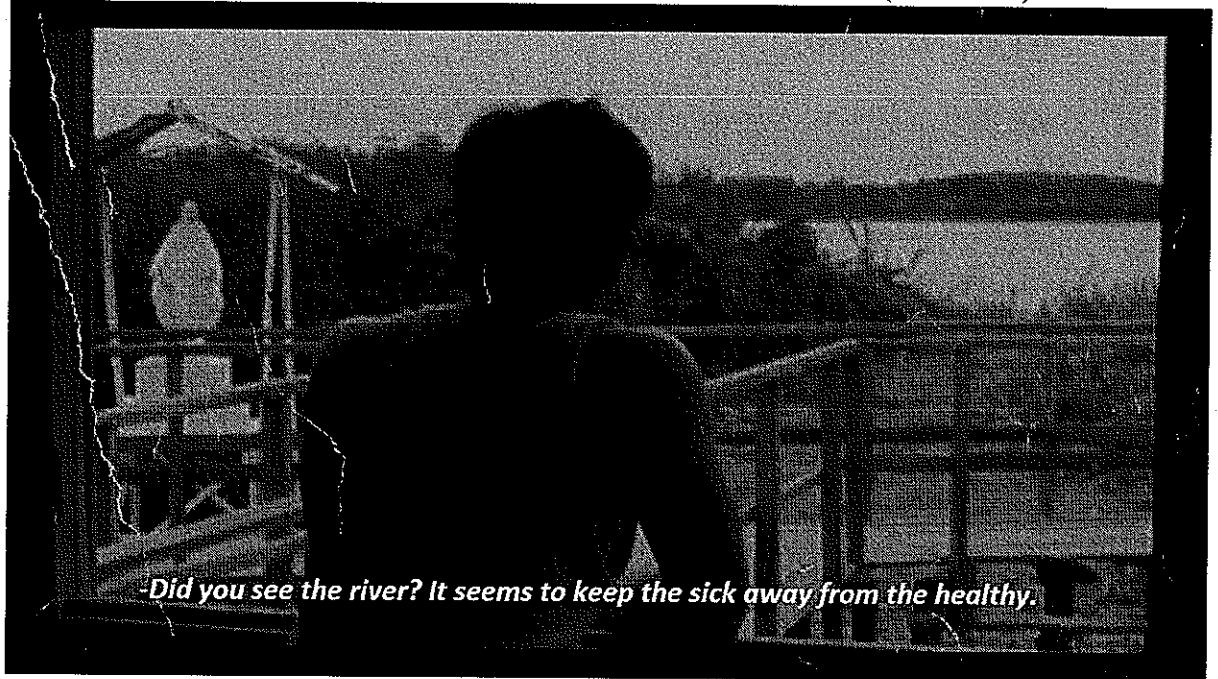


(Text in the image: "You never learned how to speak my language.")
